

Dumb Egg

Materials Needed: stickers, plastic tablecloth, felt tip pens, car or truck, ramp, eggs, plastic floor cloth, hand towels

1. Review bike safety rules below.
2. Use road safety cards to help children understand the importance of wearing a helmet anytime you are on a bike.
3. Show children helmet card and check if their helmet fits right. They must wear it properly before they can color an egg.
4. Let each child draw a face on an egg with felt-tip pens and give their egg a name. (These eggs are NOT hard boiled.)
5. Put their egg in the truck and place it on the track. Position the child at the end of the table so he will see the egg fall into the pan.

Bike Safety

1. Tricycles should not be on the road. They are considered pedestrians.
2. Ride your bike on the right side of the road.
3. Walk you bike across busy intersections.
4. Don't ride after dark.
5. Wear a helmet.
6. Ride one person to a bike.
